#### 2017 Workshop Descriptions

## Workshop #1: "The Languages of God's Love"

This workshop will guide participants towards discovering the languages through which God's love is communicated. Specific examples will be given as to how you can reflect that love back to God and to other people as well. Content is designed to revolutionize the way we understand life, and redefine our sense of purpose in this world.

### Workshop #2: "New Age Evangelism / Purposeful Mission"

The panelist for this workshop will explore the many ways the mission of the Board of Evangelism in the Primitive Baptist Church may be demonstrated through the principal of the "good Samaritan" by giving physical and spiritual assistance to communities during times of natural disasters. Available resources, partnerships, and on-site trainings will be shared.

#### 2017 Church School Courses Descriptions

1. Primitive Baptist Church Doctrine & Polity - Instructor: Elder Edward Hayes Location: Fellowship Rm. #2

This course covers the history and doctrine of the Primitive Baptist Church. It is designed to further acquaint the Primitive Baptist membership with the practices and operations of the church from a biblical and historical view, thereby developing more continuity in the faith.

2. The Purpose and Strategies For Evangelism - Instructor: Sister Willow Britt; Location: **Rm. 206** 

Emphasis is given to the need for the Church to assume its Gods given responsibility to tell the world about Jesus. The why, the who, and the how the church and its representatives can prepare for the role of an evangelist.

- 3. Christian Leadership Instructor: Elder Ester Watson; Location: Fellowship Rm. #1 This class explores a variety of areas with which the church must address today as it assist Christian caregivers in their efforts to understand their roles as leaders within the church and community. Issues such as development, training,, and conflict resolution are examined using Apostle Paul and Timothy as examples.
- 4. Church Decorum Instructor: Deacon Ed Duffee; Location: Rm. 205 Emphasis is placed on the proper execution of Parliamentary Procedures when conducting meetings, and how to employ the proper behavior for Christians in the House of God.
- 5 New Testament Study Instructor: Elder Alvin Tyson; **Location: Rm. 203**The goal of this course is to lead participants in understanding the writings of the earliest disciples by exploring the setting and purpose of each book.
- 6. Biblical Counseling and Christian Ethics Instructor: Deacon Joe Thomas Location: Rm. 202

For the Christian, ethics must be rooted in the absolutes of God's Word. This class will examine the moral question of abortion, capital punishment, Child Abuse, human sexuality and how the church is expected to respond on these critical issues as a means of reaching the masses.

7. Dynamics of Meeting the Needs of Youth & Young Adults In Ministry – Sister Sandra Ming, Instructor; Location: Rm. 204

This course will explore the aspects and benefits of training youth advisors, leaders, and others who Work with children, youth, and /or teen ministries.

- 8. Church School Administration- . Instructor: Elder Cornell Leonard; **Location: Main Sanctuary** Covers all aspects of the ministry of bring children, youth, and adults to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ, enriching their lives, and preparing them to serve Christ; makes clear the traditional purpose and function of the Primitive Baptist Church School Ministry and its vital place in the church.
- 9. Apologetics Instructor: Elder Samuel Hayes; Location: Pre-K Rm.

  The goal of this course is to lead Christians in developing a better understanding as to what Christian Apologetics is and is not, how Christians are to go about fulfilling the the mandate of defending bible truths, and the relevance of Apologetics in today's society.
