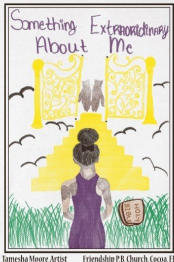
REGISTRATION FEE - \$50

ATTIRE

- ◇ Chaperones will be held responsible for the appearance of their youth. Youth are to dress appropriate for each activity. Proper dress and appropriate conduct will be enforced.
- ◇ Workshops/Competitive Events/Worship Service casual attire, however, clothing must be neat and clean. Girls are not to wear daisy dukes, no short skirts (above the thigh areas) or shirts that reveal your chest or stomach. Young men pants must be worn properly. A belt must be worn with pants.

BEHAVIOR

- ◇ Chaperones are responsible for assuring that their youth behavior is always appropriate. There will be no loitering in the hallways during Convention events. No cell phones or cell phone accessories or headphones will be allowed during Convention events. No gum or candy during Convention events will be allowed. Horse playing, running in the hotel, loud and inappropriate music, vulgar language, smoking, drinking, or any behavior that is unbecoming to a Christian will not be tolerated. This is a Christian function and our attitudes should display such.
- ◇ Any damage or missing items to the hotel property will be the responsibility of the Advisors/Chaperones. Therefore, we ask that you counsel with your youth and their parents/guardians prior to departing for the Convention regarding the liabilities associated with damages and missing items.
- ◇ Chaperones are being asked to supervise their youth and to please monitor their conduct at the park, in church services, workshops, competitive events and the banquet. Please work with your youth in respecting others when they are giving presentations, performances, etc. It is critical that the noise be curtailed during these events
- ◇ There will be a curfew hour – 11:00 p.m. The curfew hour is to be honored. Security will be available 24 hours a day. Should a youth be found in the hallways after the curfew hour, the security staff will call the chaperone down to the security office to handle the situation. Therefore, we ask that each church bring enough chaperones to make sure your youth adhere to the rules and regulations.

Name tags are to be worn at all times. There are no EXCEPTIONS. Youth are asked to be on time for all events. Plan to arrive at least 10 minutes before the event begins.
