Allen-Bartley-Frazier Scholarship Aid Guidelines - 2018

Objective: These guidelines are prepared with the anticipation of assisting those students, in need of financial assistance to further their education, who have achieved academically as well as those who have demonstrated potential for successful academic achievement.

This scholarship aid is for the current year graduating high school seniors to pursue a degree or certificate in order to become gainfully employed.

1. In order to qualify for this scholarship, an applicant must attend a Florida School. The applicant must be in good standing (morally, socially, educationally, etc.) in their school and community, and need assistance to further their education.
2. One thousand dollars (\$1,000) per district will be awarded for scholarships each year to a maximum of seven qualified applicants. If a district does not have an applicant with an average score of 80 (of 100 points available), the \$1,000 for that district will be awarded to another district.
3. Each applicant must have at least an overall 2.5 GPA (unweighted) at the end of the last grading period and submit a transcript with the last grading period included with the application. The official GPA will be verified by the official transcript.
4. The application packet must include and be postmarked no later than March 15:
 - a. A 2018 Application completed online at www.fspbc.org and printed to get proper signatures or typed on the official form. Handwritten applications will not be considered. Only "School Verification" information and applicant's signature/written name may be handwritten.
 - b. An up-to-date (through January/February 2018) resume
 - c. Letter or form verifying volunteer service (from Agency where service was performed). Volunteer hours should not be less than 40 hours and verified by a school counselor.
 - d. Only two reference letters are to be submitted with the application. One letter should come from school personnel (principal, teacher, advisor or coach). The second letter should come from an adult associated with a community organization or church. All letters must be in business format on proper letterhead, include original signatures in black or blue ink, and addressed to the Allen-Bartley-Frazier Scholarship Committee.
 - e. A one-page essay – "How This Scholarship Will Assist My Financial Need" – double-spaced, 12-point, Times New Roman, 1" sides and bottom margins, 1.5" top margin.
5. During the Annual Convention, the Scholarship Committee of the Education Foundation will screen applications and submit results to the Foundation for approval. When awardees submit verification of enrollment of at least 12 hours or equivalent and a paid registration receipt from an institution, a request will be submitted to the Foundation for payment of the \$1,000.00.
6. All Awardees must attend the Awards Presentation during the Primitive Baptist Church School Convention in the district where the applicant resides (June 2017). Failure to appear in person as notified, will result in forfeiture of the award.
